Hi,

Thanks for your help. I mistyped in the subject line. In the actual conf file they are correctly in caps:

```
ONBOOT="yes"
```

```
# UBC parameters (in form of barrier:limit)
KMEMSIZE="15252512:15252512"
```

etc...

I've not been able to test it yet but the last change I see is changing VZFASTBOOT to yes on this server:

```
DISK_QUOTA=yes
VZFASTBOOT=yes
```

(it was set to no)

I do not think this is the problem because we have it set to YES on other servers with no problem. I've not been able to test yet (can't reboot as this is a production machine) but it should have not be stopping automatic starts of the VE's from my understanding.

To manually start, I've been doing this:

```
for VE in `vzlist -SHoveid`; do echo $VE; vzctl start $VE; done
```
