Hi naro,

Thanks for the script, i was wondering how did you solve the routing issue? im having the same issue and the max i could achieve is pinging from the container out but not from the world in.

I did that by adding

```
iptables -t nat -A POSTROUTING -d 62.90.150.0/26 -j MASQUERADE -o eth0  
on NH
```

where 62.90.150.0/26 is the subnet that doesn't configured on the NH eth0.

I still not fully understand the routing procedure special the default gateway/route on the NH specially when it's not possible to add default gateway on container working with venet.

maybe the ARP table on NH will solve the issue(it does make sense) i haven't tested it yet.
