> I do have one problem, and I don't know if it is related to the change or not... but I just now noticed it... but I have one CentOS 5.6 32-bit container that is having the no pty problem. When I try to vzctl enter into it I get:

>

> Unable to open pty: No such file or directory

This sounds like the same problem I had when I recently moved some old Gentoo-containers from Linux-Vserver to OpenVZ.

Try the following command:

```
vzctl exec CTID mount -t devpts none /dev/pts
```

then try to reenter:

```
vzctl enter CTID
```

If this works, then all you have to do is add the line "mount -t devpts none /dev/pts" to the container's /etc/rc.local to make sure it stays working after a restart. There may be more elegant solutions out there, but this works for me.
