OK I can acknowledge there is a problem for yum-3.0 users. I reproduced it using CentOS 5 host.

The thing is, we have upgraded download.openvz.org to use CentOS 6, and by default its createrepo uses sha256 for checksumming, which yum-3.0 does not understand.

The fix is to use -s sha argument to createrepo. I have just updated download.openvz.org.

Mirrors should follow within hours.
