Well, as usual you should take a look at /proc/user_beancounters, find the affected CTs, increase their limits, check the validity of CT configuration (vzcfgvalidate), then check that the system as a whole is not overcommitted (vzmemcheck). Or, in case you are using vswap, things are a little bit different. But since you have migrated from rhel5 kernel you are probably not using vswap.
