eth2 = dummy

eth2.722 = iscsi

eth3 = dummy

eth3.722 = iscsi

Normally the Venet uses eth0 to talk to the outside world in this case it needs to be eth0.730. I can't use bridging because if i do that i can not ssh to the HN anymore. any suggestions?
