Running SL 6.0 on one machine, 6.1 on 2 more; no resource issues at all. In fact, SL 6.\* is \*much\* better about IO sharing between containers than CENTOS 5.\* was.

There is an issue with /dev/ptmx though for some of our old RHEL4-based VEs, but that is solved easily enough.

My advice, if your are having lockups in CENT5, upgrade to SL 6.\*. If you still have issues, it's not OpenVZ or the OS, it's your configs or hardware.

Planning to migrate 8 more nodes from CENT5 to SL6.1 in the next 30 days ... rock on!
