I have an older node, using HyperVM, that I have 2 large VPS containers on. Occasionally, the containers will simultaniously fill up the dcachesize limits, and start erroring out. The only fix is for me to reboot the node. This happens, on average, 2-3x monthly. At first, I though it was the old kernal, I was using, so I updated it, and the issue persists.

On another note, I have SolusVM nodes, also running OpenVZ, that are running an older kernal of 2.6.18-238.19.1.el5.028stab092.2, which do not have this dcachesize issue. Those are also CentOS 5.7 x86\_64

What can I do to fix this problem? The HyperVM node, is where I host my shared hosting clients.
