Hi All,

I'm in the lab testing debian squeeze and OVZ. The current debian repository is listing this for the OVZ kernel:

How does the debian kernel version 2.6.32-\*[38]\* coorespond to the official OVZ release cycle kernels, the current stable release being (vzkernel-2.6.32-042stab040.1.src.rpm )?

Does this indicate the debian kernel is 4 stable releases behind? Is anyone using the squeeze repository OVZ kernel? Any feedback on stability or use would be appriciated.
