> This patch moves static SUNRPC clients list and it's lock to sunrpc\_net  
> structure.  
> Currently this list is used only for debug purposes. But later it will be used  
> also for selecting clients by networks namespace on PipeFS mount/umount events.  
> Per-network namespace lists will make this faster and simpler.  
>  
> Note: client list is taken from "init\_net" network namespace context in  
> rpc\_show\_tasks(). This will be changed with making SUNRPC sysctl's per network  
> namespace context.  
>
