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Are sit tunnel interfaces supported in containers? I want to virtualize a tunnel server but the sit interface isn't created. The standard network startup script complains:

Bringing up interface sit1: ioctl: No such device

The host and container are both SL 6.1.

/etc/sysconfig/network-scripts/ifcfg-sit1 looks like:

```
DEVICE=sit1
BOOTPROTO=none
ONBOOT=yes
IPV6INIT=yes
IPV6TUNNELIPV4=x.x.x.x
IPV6TUNNELIPV4LOCAL=y.y.y.y
IPV6ADDR=zzzz:zzzz:zzzz:zzzz::z/126
```

like it does on a real host where sit interfaces work. What am I missing?

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
