
Subject: Ulogd + iptables configuration

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Hello,

I am trying to configure a Debian 6 container. In this container, I want all iptables logs to be written in a MySQL DB. To achieve this, I am using ulogd and ulogd-mysql packages on the container.

On the HW node, which is a CentOS 5 machine, I enabled ipt_ULOG module according to the OpenVZ User's Guide (i.e. by adding ipt_ULOG to /etc/sysconfig/iptables-config file, and rebooting). I also added ipt_ULOG to the container's configuration file and rebooted the container. However, I am getting a warning like "ipt_ULOG not found, skipping" while rebooting the container. As a result, I cannot install ulogd and ulogd-mysql to the container due to errors about ipt_ULOG module.

Are there any ideas to fix this issue?
