Recently one of our client suffered because his VPS stopped booting. I tried starting it from main node but i get the following.

```
vzctl start 336
```

```
Starting container ...

```

Both our main node and the container(VPS) is running Centos 5.

I would like to copy MYSQL DB And the Home directory from the effected container to my main node. And then copy them to another container. (I have 0 knowledge)
