I'm using RHEL6 kernel with VIA C3 CPU, where PAE isn't present and it works well. It is necessary to manually disable PAE in RHEL6 kernel configuration. If not, kernel is unbootable on VIA C3.

KVM nor Xen don't require Intel Hyper-Threading technology. Intel HTT isn't related to any for me known virtualization technology. It's type of multithreading processing over CPU (called SMT).
