I was hoping your answer would provide some clue on how to solve this, but everything looks fine to me...

What I'd do at this point is:

- check on CT1 if /proc/filesystems contains reiserfs (I'm guessing that it doesn't)
- try with CT2 using CentOS 6 as OS, for better comparison.

If both CT1 and CT2 behave the same, then I'd assume it's a deeper issue and that reiserfs and openvz don't play nicely together. You might have more luck catching the attention of one of the openvz developers on the mailing list for further help. They seem to frequent there more.

I'm sure you're also aware of bind mounts as an option, I'm just mentioning it here for the sake of completeness or if anyone else is reading the thread.
