> So, if I understand you right, we can create rpc client (or increase usage counter) on NSMPROC_MON call and destroy (or decrease usage counter) on NSMPROC_UNMON call.

> Will this solution works?

The rpc client(s) will need to be per-net-namespace, which complicates matters a little bit, but yes, creation at NSMPROC_MON, and destruction at NSMPROC_UNMON should work.
