You created a container with Ubuntu linux. Ubuntu is based on Debian and uses deb packages, not rpms. Yum doesn't exist on Ubuntu systems, use apt.

I suggest starting with a how-to or a book about basic Ubuntu commands... Or create a CentOS 6 or Scientific Linux 6 container instead, if you're more familiar with yum and Red Hat based OS'es in general. Good luck!
