1. In OpenVZ kernel from rpm autofs is off, so if you want to use autofs on HOST with OpenVZ you should recompile your kernel with CONFIG\_AUTOFS\_FS, CONFIG\_AUTOFS4\_FS parameters on.
2. However autofs (and nfs) are not virtualized, so you can't use it inside VE.
3. You can mount autofs somewhere on HOST, and then do --bind mount inside any VE you wish. May be such scenario passes for you.
4. Yeap, there were some patches here at forum, that makes autofs/nfs available in VE. Try to use search. However, after such patching you kernel becomes unsecure.
