Mount/Umount scripts worked just fine:

Since each user usually gets one vps in my setup. I only have to mount one home in each vps. So for the ftp server (vps 1001) it goes like this:

1001.mount:

#!/bin/sh

mount -o bind,ro /vz/home/ftp /vz/root/\$VEID/home/ftp

1001.umount:

#!/bin/sh

umount /vz/root/\$VEID/home/ftp

#vzctl ecec 1001 df
