Mount/Umount scripts worked just fine:

Since each user usually gets one vps in my setup. I only have to mount one home in each vps. So for the ftp server (vps 1001) it goes like this:

1001.mount:

```
#!/bin/sh
```

```
mount -o bind,ro /vz/home/ftp /vz/root/$VEID/home/ftp
```

1001.umount:

```
#!/bin/sh
```

```
umount /vz/root/$VEID/home/ftp
```

```
#vzctl ecec 1001 df
```
