smbfs/cifs isn't virtualized now,  
you can't use it inside VE.

All available in VE filesystems resides in /proc/ filesystems  
file inside VE.

You can do the following to make smb shares available in VE:

On HOST (!):

```
mount -t cifs //192.168.1.30/test /mn
```

```
mount --bind /mn /vz/root/101/mn
```

After that you can see contents of //192.168.1.30/test  
inside VE in /mn directory.

You can automate this process using 101.mount and 101.umount  
scripts in conf directory of OpenVZ.
