Using the script I gave you, you can tell which CT has high load. Once you know that, you can run a linux command in that CT to find out which process consumes the CPU. For example:

```
vzctl exec 320 top -b -n 1 | head -20
```

Or: `vzctl exec 320 top -b -n 1 | grep mysql`

Also note that all container processes are also HN processes.

So this command on the HN will tell you something about all the mysql processes:

```
ps -ef | grep mysql
```
