My experiments show that setting the route with

/sbin/route add default dev venet0

on the VPS is sufficient.

But if you have the line

OSTEMPLATE=gentoo-something

in your config file (eg. /etc/vz/777.conf) the routes are added automatically when you set up the ip address. However they look different:
