After installing the kernel using the package `linux-image-2.6.32-openvz-amd64`, as per the wiki on [Installation_on_Debian](#), debsums reports integrity problems. I purged, reinstalled, deleted the problem directory and reinstalled, debsums always reports failures, whether I'm using that kernel or 3.2 to boot.

`debsums | grep -v OK`
