I have noticed that after install openvz kernel, new file in /etc/modprobe.conf is created with the next line:

```
options ip_conntrack ip_conntrack_disable_ve0=1
```

If I comment the line of the file then I can apply the rule and centos does not complain like before.

Why this? I don't understand. Can you give me some information about it?
