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vzctl prints the following upon adding this line:

Due to conntrack impact on venet performance, conntrack need to be disabled on the host system (it will still work for containers).

Adding the following option to /etc/modprobe.d/openvz.conf

```
options nf_conntrack ip_conntrack_disable_ve0=1
```

This change will take effect only after the next reboot.

NOTE: IF YOU NEED conntrack functionality, edit \$file NOW, changing =1 to =0. DO NOT REMOVE the line, or it will be re-added!
