In debian 7 (wheezy) with VZDump 1.2.3-3 is following workaround,

In file "/usr/share/perl5/PVE/VZDump.pm"

after line 1077 "foreach my \$task (@\$tasklist) {"

i added:

```
if ($opts->{'exclude-path'}) {  
    $task->{'exclude-path'}=$opts->{'exclude-path'};  
}
```

And in file "/usr/share/perl5/PVE/VZDump/OpenVZ.pm"

after line 147 "my \$rsyncopts = "--stats -x --numeric-ids --bwlimit=\$opts->{bwlimit}";"

i added:

```
my $excludes = " ";  
foreach my $path (@{$task->{'exclude-path'}}){  
    my $pathu=substr($path, 1, length($path)-4);  
    $excludes = $excludes." --exclude '$pathu';"  
}
```

```
$self->cmd ("rsync $rsyncopts -aH --delete --no-whole-file --inplace $excludes '$from' '$to');"  
and commented with # $self->cmd ("rsync $rsyncopts -aH --delete --no-whole-file --inplace '$from'  
'$to');
```
