
Subject: OpenVZ HN became sluggish

I have a weird problem. My OpenVZ HN became sluggish since yesterday. At the moment there is only one running VPS container which is not using too much resources as far as i can see with Glances.

I run Linux joe 2.6.32-042stab094.8 #1 SMP Tue Dec 16 20:36:56 MSK 2014 x86_64 x86_64
x86_64 GNU/Linux

What are the problems:

- When i TOP the refreshrate hangs and goes further after 10 seconds
- When i connect to sftp, it is terribly slow and when i want to download something, the download fails most of the time.
- Login to OpenVZ HN trough SSH can take 10-15 seconds until password has been asked.

Strange part is that the VPS container is quick. Login trough sftp works like it should.

The server has 2 quad core CPU's and 32GB of ram.
