Was VPS in running state when you tried to do --bind mount? /vps/v1 is 'private' or 'root' VPS directory?

To do correct bind mount you need:

1. Start VPS

2. mount --bind /root\_VPS\_directory/etc /root\_VPS\_directory/mnt

Or you can add mounting/umounting to VEID.mount/.umount scripts and vzctl will mount/umount your directories on VPS start/stop.
