I'm trying to install OpenVPN package on a CentOS 6 distro in a OVZ container. Everything goes ok, until i want to setup iptables. When i put in a string i get:

Quote:"iptables: No chain/target/match by that name"

So, i checked the manual and came by

x86_64 GNU/Linux and it looks like module xt_tcpudp isn't even there. Modules.dep also does not show it.

How can i run this module without error?
