Thank you for your reply.

I tried issuing the following command from within my mounted tar file:

[root@server18 root.hdd]# ploop mount root.hdd.\{4410aa10-0157-437d-b0c5-0efc3f0c0b91\} Adding delta dev=/dev/ploop55202 img=root.hdd.{4410aa10-0157-437d-b0c5-0efc3f0c0b91} (rw) Error in add\_delta (ploop.c:1174): Can't open file root.hdd.{4410aa10-0157-437d-b0c5-0efc3f0c0b91}: Invalid argument

As you can see, the mount didn't succeed. Am I missing something, or could this be a sign that the image is corrupted?

I guess it could also be because I haven't extrated the TAR-file first. Would it be an idea to try that?
