> Task references three beancounters:

- > 1. exec\_ub current context. all resources are

- > 2. task\_ub beancounter to which task\_struct is  
> charged itself.
- > 3. fork\_sub beancounter which is inherited by  
> task's children on fork

Is there a case where exec\_ub and fork\_sub can differ? I dont see that  
in the patch.
