I have been trialing openvz 7 for a few months now and just ran the latest yum update. This has resulted in a dependency error on qemu-kvm-vz-2.9.0-16.3.vz7.6.x86\_64.

The current installed version of qemu-kvm-vz is qemu-kvm-vz-2.6.0-28.3.10.vz7.75.x86\_64.

In the repos it looks like SPICE\_SERVER\_0.12.4 is the newest available (
