I did some more testing.

After reboot in older kernel the slub error seems to reappear, but less than with the latest kernel. So it does seem to be related with the update, I think that some other kernel settings are changed during the latest kernel install and are still active after booting an older kernel.

Before I did the kernel update everything was fine and no errors whatsoever. The scripts that are causing the errors are a quota tally script from DirectAdmin and an own made script to set ownership of files in the Home folders of users.

Also when I boot in the latest kernel I also get the same issue as martv describes. I can restart vps server but after about 15 minutes this does not work anymore and the vps is mounted as ploop device, but no vps start.

I thought I let the server do his thing, but after 1 hour still nothing happened and the whole server hangs. Only a reboot helps!
