yum localinstall

https://download.openvz.org/virtuozzo/releases/openvz-7.0.7-361/x86\_64/os/Packages/o/openvz-release-7.0.7-1.vz7.x86 64.rpm

yum install prlctl prl-disp-service vzkernel

reboot
