Hi,

yes, every "iron" translates this new nowadays, so your question is definitely valid and expected.

Fortunately this will not affect OpenVZ 8 anyhow - even at the moment we don't use CentOS as a base,

we do rebuild RHEL packages ourselves (it's just faster then waiting for CentOS packages).

The only interesting question here is - what is going to be with CentOS-based Containers. This is not decided yet: definitely we will suggest some way (the best way, of course!).

There will be probably a new template(s?) instead of CentOS one for new Containers it might be another incarnation of our own VzLinux (or whatever name will be chosen) or template of RockyLinux/OracleLinux/CloudLinux/etc - there are a lot of them appeared right after announcement of stable CentOS death.
