> RCU means softirq, probably we can use spin\_lock\_bh() to protect against deadlock.

> But free\_uid() may be called with irqs disabled, we can't use local\_bh\_enable()
> in such a case.

Eek, I wasn't really aware of it and this would really suck. We should move things out of the interrupt context and not into it. :( I would call it a bug in the rcu system.
