Is it ok, what in vps'es we have both, and virt\_osrelease and osrelease sysctl variables?

```
# sysctl -a | grep osrelease  
error: "Invalid argument" reading key "net.ipv4.route.flush"  
error: "Operation not permitted" reading key "kernel.cap-bound"  
kernel.virt_osrelease = 2.6.18  
kernel.osrelease = 2.6.8-022stab078-up
```

`uname -r` get his value from kernel.virt\_osrelease, but I can just look right version of kernel from sysctl...
