It's also not very practical to install a "Bear" such as Gentoo if your main purpose is only to debootstrap from an RPM based box. I was lucky to have just installed Gentoo recently on a local machine. I had trouble finding a RPM for debootstrap which was functional for 3.1 sarge. Now I have the RPM for future use
