I have the same problem (except Im trying to forward a port inside the vps from the host and not outside as peian above - port 8080 of host into port 80 of VPS), and I have iptable\_nat loaded before vps start, as well as conntrack enabled on ve0. Probably i (we) are missing some module/setting for iptables, but i cant find which one. My config:

192.168.8.128 is the host address (running in vmware, but that shouldnt count) 10.1.1.1 is the vps address - i can ssh into the vps from the host

# iptables -t nat -A PREROUTING -p tcp -d 192.168.8.128 --dport 8080 -j DNAT --to 10.1.1.1:80

after adding this line to iptables, i just get a connection refused on 192.168.8.128:8080. All rules are set to accept, i dont use any other iptables settings currently.
