No, it's not compiled, as "iptables -nvL -t nat" showed it. But I thought it's host problem. The traffic supposed to be intercepted by host, and not seen at all by VPS. So it doesn't matter if iptables nat is enabled or not in VPS, right?

"iptables -nvL -t nat" in host does work. It report 0 pkts and 0 bytes for prerouting chain.

Is there additional rule/chain/target I should add to iptables?
