Suppose, <veid> is id of your VE.

If this VE is not started files are only in /vz/private/<veid> and /vz/root/<veid> is empty. After starting VE, simfs file system is mounted on /vz/root/<veid>. Simfs file system _reflects_ contents of /vz/private/<veid>. It's done to confine VE in /vz/root/<veid>.

So, you don't have duplicate space on machine, don't worry!
