The problem is the supervise program does not start because it's allready started in the vps, if i issue "ps aux | grep supervise " the process appears in the list but is the vps's process not the host's.

For those who do not use qmail the supervise program is responsible for starting qmail's "daemons", something similar to inetd.

The help states that the supervise program does not start if it detects that's allready running. And it seems that it does that by searching it's name in the process list because after i turned off the qmail server vps's the supervise process doesn't show up in the process list anymore! After a reboot the qmail server on the host system is running fine.
