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Hi all,

I have troubles with quagga and FC5 (kernel: 2.6.15-1.2054_FC5.026test006) and RHEL4 (CentOS 4.4, kernel: 2.6.9-023stab016.2). Quagga routing daemon (zebra) can not insert routes into kernel. Error is:
