I don't need any vzctl support, I just want to specify the content of my /etc/networks/interfaces file

You can use VEID.start script which is executed inside VE on start to configure veth interface inside VE. Something like this:

```
#!/bin/bash
ifconfig eth0 0
ip a add a.b.c.d dev eth0
ip ro add default dev eth0
```
