I am trying to install OpenVZ for the first time but am not being able to install it using ovzkernel-2.6.8-022stab078.14.i686.rpm.

it gives me following error.

rpm -ihv ovzkernel-2.6.8-022stab072.2.i686.rpm

Then while searching on forum i found a reply asking to try

rpm -ihv --nodeps ovzkernel-2.6.8-022stab072.2.i686.rpm which cud install the kernel then i followed the /etc/sysctl.conf setting which have been explained @ http://wiki.openvz.org/Quick\_installation

But when i try to reboot the system it doesnt do anything I dont have sata drive but an ide 80 gb drive.(somewhere i found this can also be the reason)

it shows:

uncompressing linux ..ok .. booting .. initrd:GRUB workaround enabled

After this nothing happens ...

Can u tell me what do i need to do to make it work . I went for stable one for just to make it work first and it didnt .So any help would be gr8ly appreciated.
