I have noticed on my test machine (at home), it has an odd network card in it and I have found that the openvz kernel does not have the network card driver for it compiled into it due to errors when I boot it. I just recently bought a dedicated server and have a few questions.

I ran the command `lspci` to find which network card the dedicated server has:
01:03.0 Ethernet controller: Realtek Semiconductor Co., Ltd. RTL-8139/8139C/8139C+ (rev 10)

Is this driver compiled into the kernel already? I dont want to set the openvz kernel to boot permanently as this kernel fearing that I will not have ssh access to the server. Then I have to have a technician come out and fix it, which costs \$\$.
