I really don't believe that there is a problem with the contiguous memory blocks - I'm running openVz on several different hardware nodes using CentOS 4.[3|4] (vps and host OS) 32-bit. These VPS run resource intensive java-apps like zimbra, alfresco, JBoss Portal and so on without any problems. Several smaller tomcat apps are running on these servers, too. No problems since more than eight months.

Ensure that your memory setting of the VM correspondent with the memory settings of the VPS and remember that the OS itself needs some memory.
