> vzpid 102  
> 102 is the VE (VPS)

vzpid shows *\*only\** the VEID of a given PID !!!!  
The argument must be a PID not a VEID !!!

If you want to list all PID of the VE you can use :  
Poor man's vzps in bash . (wiki) -> [http://wiki.openvz.org/Processes\\_scope\\_and\\_visibility](http://wiki.openvz.org/Processes_scope_and_visibility)  
or compile the vzprocs package (-> <http://download.openvz.org/contrib/utls/vzprocs-2.0.11-6.1.2.swsoft.src.rpm>) , with hold's a modified ps and top!
