Currently, I'm running 2 UML instances on a Debian host.

If I've understood things right, the main difference between OpenVZ and UML is that OpenVZ uses a common kernel for all VPSs whereas with UML one can use different kernels as UML instances?

What about security issues? Has OpenVZ there some advantages towards UML?
